1. **To promote and encourage the building, ownership and enjoyment of Sabres, Dropheads and Windsors.** The club can assist with the technicalities of your build and spares availability by putting you in touch with Royale owners.
2. **To encourage the improvement of the standard of kit car construction by providing facilities for the exchange of news and technical information between the members.** The club has a technical co-ordinator who can assist with any problems/queries you may have. Technical information has been scanned and can now be sent electronically to members. The club also has an archivist who collates Royale history and records individual car details.
3. **To represent and safeguard the interests of members at kit car events and at other venues, committees, meetings etc as appropriate.** The club will attend as many shows as possible. This will enable potential owners to make face to face contact and inspect owner's cars.

The club will normally attend the main kit car show and reserve space for members to display their cars when available.

The club produces a quality magazine posted quarterly to all members.

The club organises annual holidays.
